ETHICS

- Ethics is the study of the way things ought to be.
- Ethics applies to topics as ordinary as preparing for tests and as momentous as how to structure governments.
- Studying Ethics can give you deep insights into what people do and why they do it.
- If you let it studying Ethics can motivate you to change morally questionable habits and live an ethical life.
