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Let's discuss...

- Courtesy is showing respect for others.
- We should always apologise when we do something wrong - even if it's an accident try to make amends.

- What other actions show courtesy?

- After you receive a gift make sure you write a thank you note or follow up with a phone call, email or text.
- Remember saying "shut up" is not courteous its offensive.
